

POSITIVE REWARD SCHEME

Starting in January 2007 the school will be operating a positive reward scheme for pupils in S1 – S3. All pupils will be issued with collecting cards and it is then their responsibility to keep these safe.

Where teachers feel that a pupil deserves special praise they will also reward them with a credit sticker. Examples of when stickers may be awarded include

- Where a pupil has achieved a particular goal or target.
- Where a pupil has been particularly helpful towards another pupil or a member of staff.
- Where a pupil has made considerable improvements in their behaviour.
- Where a pupil has maintained consistently high standards.

Once a pupil has received 10 credit stickers they should show their recording card to their registration teacher. This achievement will then be recorded on the school computer system and the pupil will be asked to go down to the school office who will arrange for a card to be sent home.

At the end of each term all pupils will have their cards collected and the number of credits counted. Pupils will then receive bronze, silver or gold awards at assemblies depending on the number of credits they have received.

At the end of the session, those pupils who have received the highest number of stickers will be rewarded with a special day out of school.
