What skills will I develop?

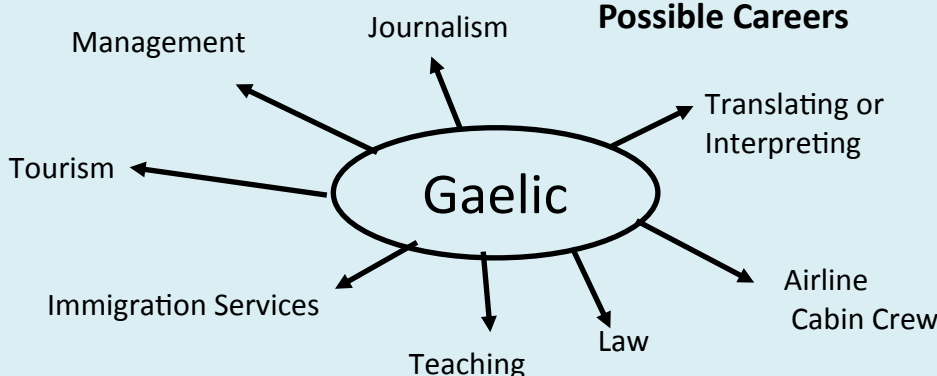
- Reading, listening, talking and writing in Gaelic
