How will I be assessed?

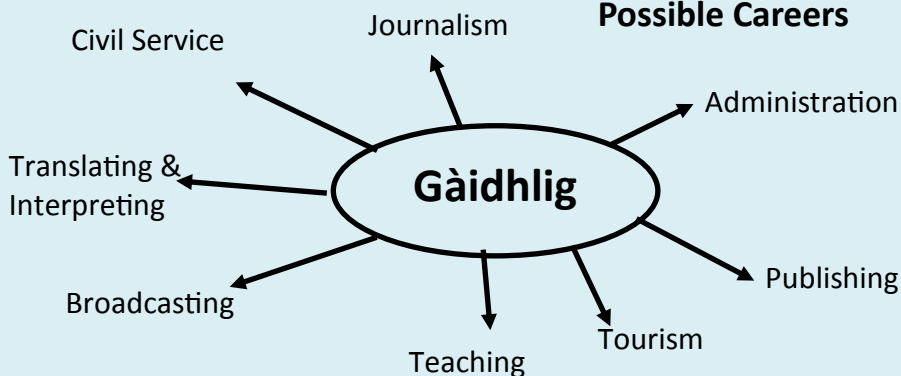
The external exam consists of 2 papers -

Paper 2	Listening	20 marks
