What will I study?

The course offers a variety of topics, a selection of which students will study in order to develop their knowledge of straightforward language. These topics are divided into four main contexts -

Context 1: Literature Context 2: Language Context 3: Media Context 4: Culture

What skills will I develop?

- Listening, reading, talking and writing in Gàidhlig
- Understanding, analysing and evaluating straightforward texts
- An ability to create and produce straightforward texts
- An ability to apply knowledge of language
- A knowledge of Gàidhlig cultural heritage and the cultural heritage of others

How will I be assessed?


There are three mandatory units which you will need to pass -

Producing lanfguage tests your talking and writing skills

Literacy tests your ability to communicate ideas and information orally and in writing
