

## What will I study?

The course offers a variety of topics, a selection of which students will study in order to develop their knowledge of straightforward language. These topics are divided into four main contexts -

- Context 1: Literature
- Context 2: Language
- Context 3: Media
- Context 4: Culture

## What skills will I develop?

- Listening, reading, talking and writing in Gàidhlig
- Understanding, analysing and evaluating straightforward texts
- An ability to create and produce straightforward texts
- An ability to apply knowledge of language
- A knowledge of Gàidhlig cultural heritage and the cultural heritage of others

## How will I be assessed?

There are four mandatory units which you will need to pass -

**Analysis and Evaluation** tests your reading and listening skills

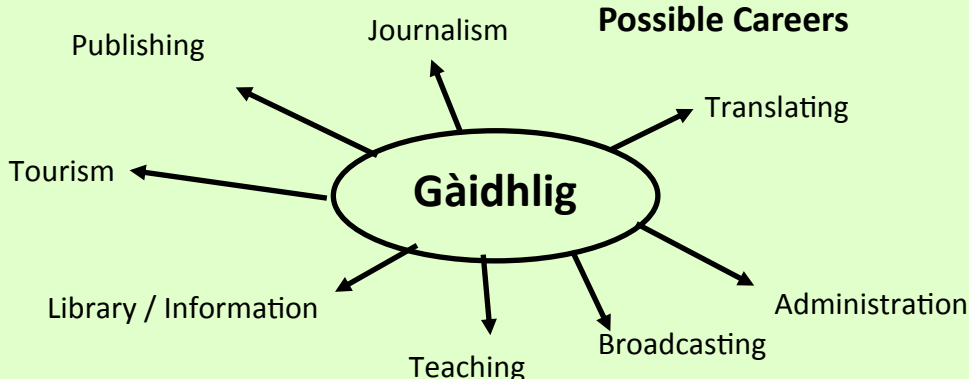
**Creation and Production** tests your talking and writing skills

**Literacy** tests your ability to communicate ideas and information orally and in writing

**Added Value** : assignment you will develop the ability to apply your language skills to investigate a report on a chosen topic
