The course offers students an opportunity to develop their reading, critical reading, listening, talking and writing skills in order to understand and use Gàidhlig language. This language will be divided into four main contexts:

- Context 1: Literature
- Context 2: Language
- Context 3: Media
- Context 4: Culture

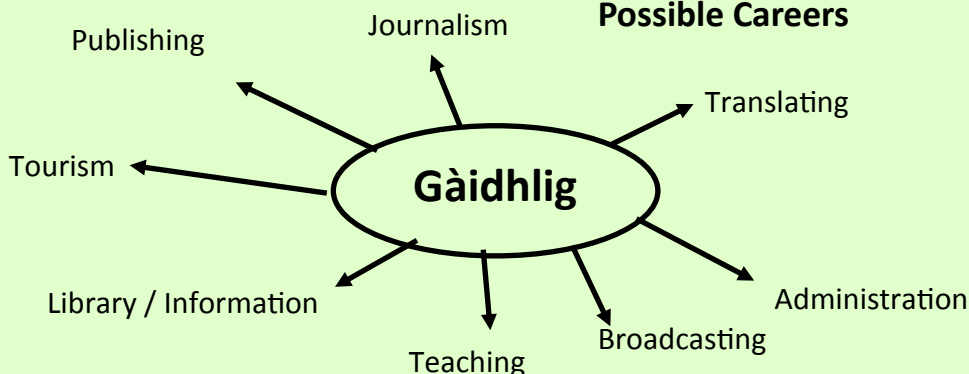
What skills will I develop?

- Reading, critical reading, listening, talking and writing skills
- Understanding, analysing and evaluating detailed written and spoken texts
- An ability to create and produce detailed texts
- An ability to apply knowledge and understanding of language

How will I be assessed?

The external exam consists of 3 papers -
Paper 1 : Reading 30 marks
Paper 2 : Writing 20 marks
Paper 3 : Listening 20 marks
There is a talking performance which is prepared and assessed within the department which is worth 30 marks.
There is a writing assignment prepared within the department but marked externally by the SQA which is worth 20 marks.
