

What will I study?

You will:

- develop complex skills in solo instrumental or vocal performance
- rehearse a varied programme of music
- develop a relatively wide knowledge of your chosen instrument/voice
- present a musical performance lasting 10 minutes

To successfully pass the unit, you must:

- carry out an effective music practice routine, keeping a diary of your progress
- describe the music chosen for performance in a small programme note
- perform music from contrasting styles

What skills will I develop?

Studying music can help to:

- Create a sense of achievement
- Boost your performance skills and reduce anxiety
- Refine your time management and organisational skills
- Nurture self-expression and relieve stress
- Teach you perseverance and discipline

How will I be assessed?

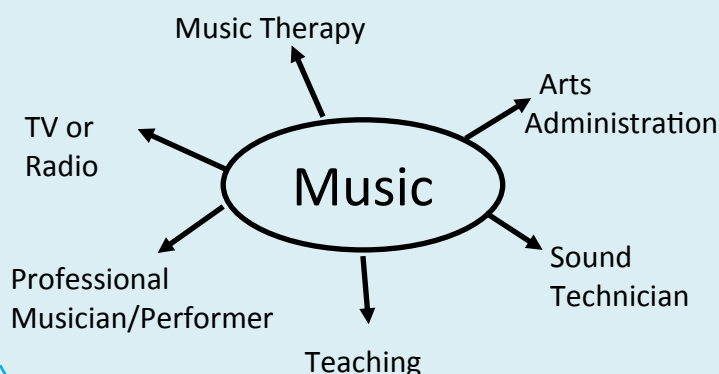
This is a unit only and so there will be no final exam. If you successfully achieve all of the requirements of the unit you will be awarded a 'pass' and not an A, B, C etc.

All parts of the unit will be assessed by the Music Department staff and will be checked by SQA.
