What will I study?

There are 3 units of study and topics include:

<u>Understanding Business</u>: The role of business in society, types of business organisations, their objectives and how they are structured and managed.

<u>Marketing and Operations</u>: Market research, marketing mix, consumer behaviour, stock management, methods of production, quality assurance, ethical and environmental issues and business, technology in marketing and operations.

<u>Management of People and Finance</u>: Workforce planning, recruitment and selection, training and development of staff, motivation and leadership, employee relations, employee legislation, the role/sources of finance, cash flow/budgeting, final accounts and ratios.

What skills will I develop?

Employability: work related skills.

ICT: using and learning about technology in various work related situations.

Thinking, analytical and evaluating.

Decision making and reflecting upon and justifying your decisions.

Enterprising: being creative and coming up with new ideas.

Communication/Literacy: being able to clearly put your point across and present facts orally and in writing. Listen and respond appropriately to other people's point of view.

Research: using various sources, analysing and evaluating these sources.

Numeracy: working with numbers and interpreting financial information/graphs.



How will I be assessed?

- The course assignment is worth 25% of the overall course award. Pupils choose, research and write a report on a business of their choice which is marked externally by the SQA.
- The SQA examination is worth 75% of the overall course award and assesses elements from all units of the course.
