What will I study?


In this course, you will take part in a number of exciting, hands-on activities. There are two main components: work with an associated primary school and the accredited Supporting Adult Literacies (SCQF 6) course, delivered through HighLife Highland.

Literacy work with the primary school entails learning about early literacies and working directly with P6/7 pupils to improve aspects of their literacy. You will design and deliver activities to promote their literacy. The pupils value your input, and it helps them with their transition to the Academy.

The Supporting Adult Literacies course is where you will gain academic credit. This course guides you through common barriers to learning and literacy, and introduces you to the world of working with adults.

How will I be assessed?
