

What will I study?

It is hoped that the new National 3 BSL course will be available for the start of August 2018. This will comprise of 2 units (Understanding Language and Using Language) mandatory for all students.

The course will follow similar coursework / assessments to the previous units and other modern language units.

In conjunction with this, pupils will also study the existing SQA units:

- Deaf awareness
- Working with Children and Young People with a Hearing Loss

What skills will I develop?

- Communication skills using Sign Language and spoken English
- Working with others, either in pairs or as a team
- Module 4 will provide students with the opportunity to further develop their BSL skills and working experiences with young people.

How will I be assessed?

Understanding Language & Using Language

Written assessments and video evidence of students signing

Working with Children and Young People with a Hearing Loss

Written assessment and folio

What help will BSL & Deaf Studies be after school?

This is a useful qualification to hold if your intention is to work with members of the public
