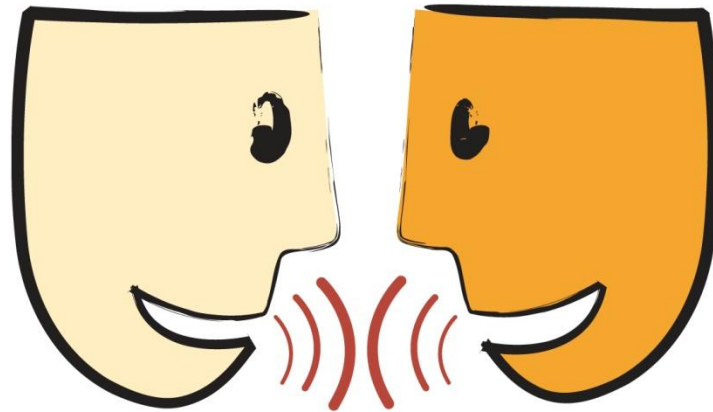

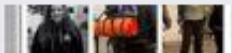

BUT...

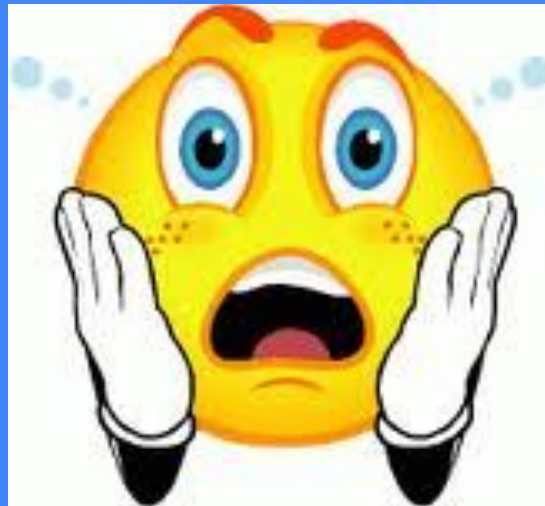


90% ATTENDANCE

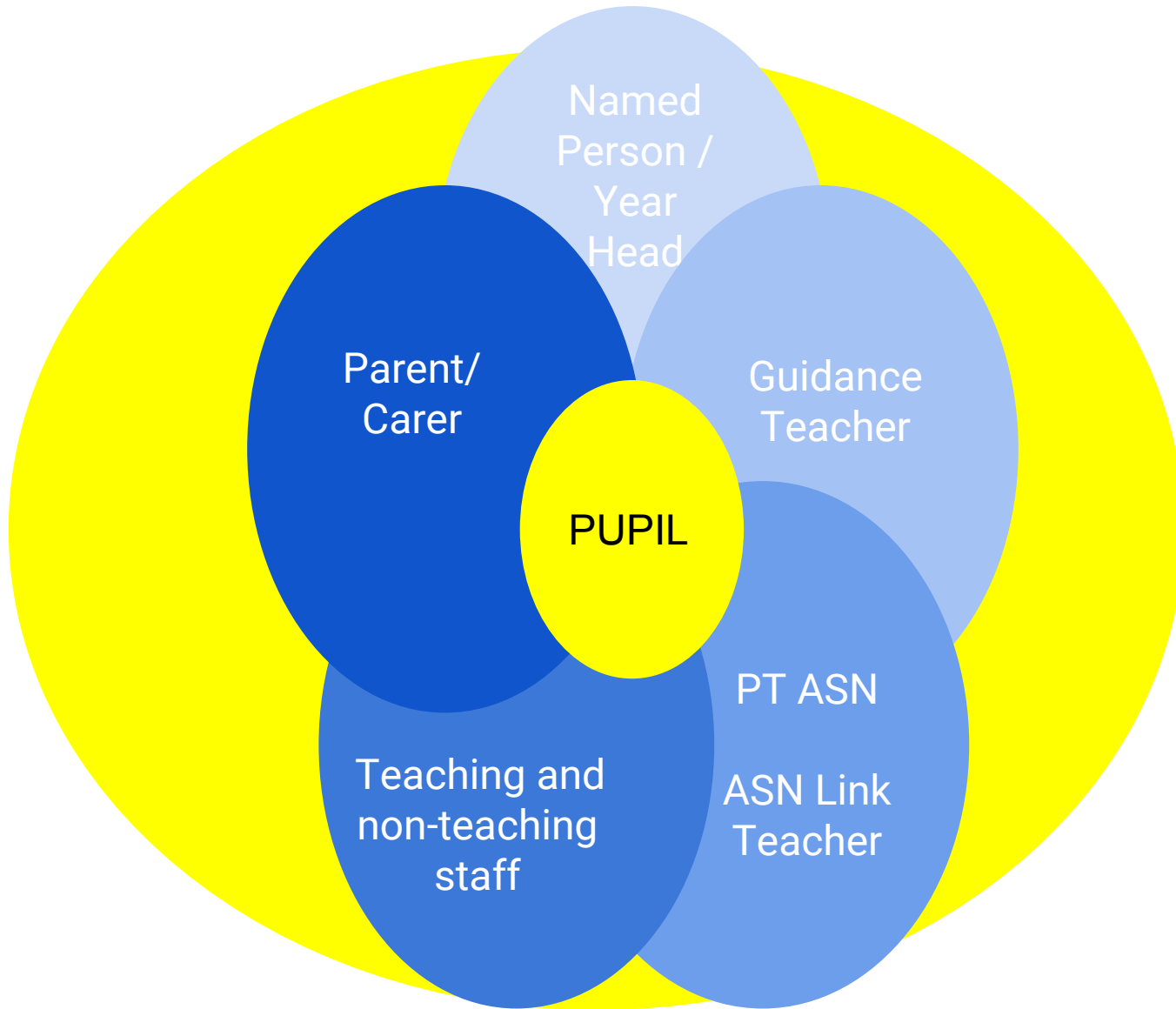

“TARGETED SUPPORT”

For pupils with known needs.

Pupils are allocated an ASN Link Teacher.

ASN Link Teacher maintains the overview of the learning needs and how these can be met.

The ASN Teacher is the main point of contact about the pupil’s learning.



Targeted Support - sharing information

Guidance and ASN Teachers have been working with the Primary Schools

Profiles of pupils' support needs are shared for all Dingwall Staff to access:

- The factor(s) that give(s) rise to the additional support need.
- How learning and teaching is affected
- Suggested strategies.
- Also the ASN Level, name of the ASN Link Teacher, date of entry and assessment arrangements.

This is treated confidentially and updated as required.



Targeted Support ASN Levels 1 - 4

The type of support depends on the level of need and is planned to help a pupil to overcome the barrier to learning and become more independent in their learning.

Level 1: Needs are met at classroom level using strategies such as seating arrangements, differentiating work, use of ICT etc. The ASN Link Teacher monitors.

Level 2: Direct support in some classes and/or Tutorial (Literacy, numeracy, health & well-being, ICT to support learning)

Level 3: Moderate direct support and Tutorial.

Level 4: High level of support, may be taught in ASN Base for some subjects.

There is a large team of ASN Teachers and Pupil Support Assistants all here to help.

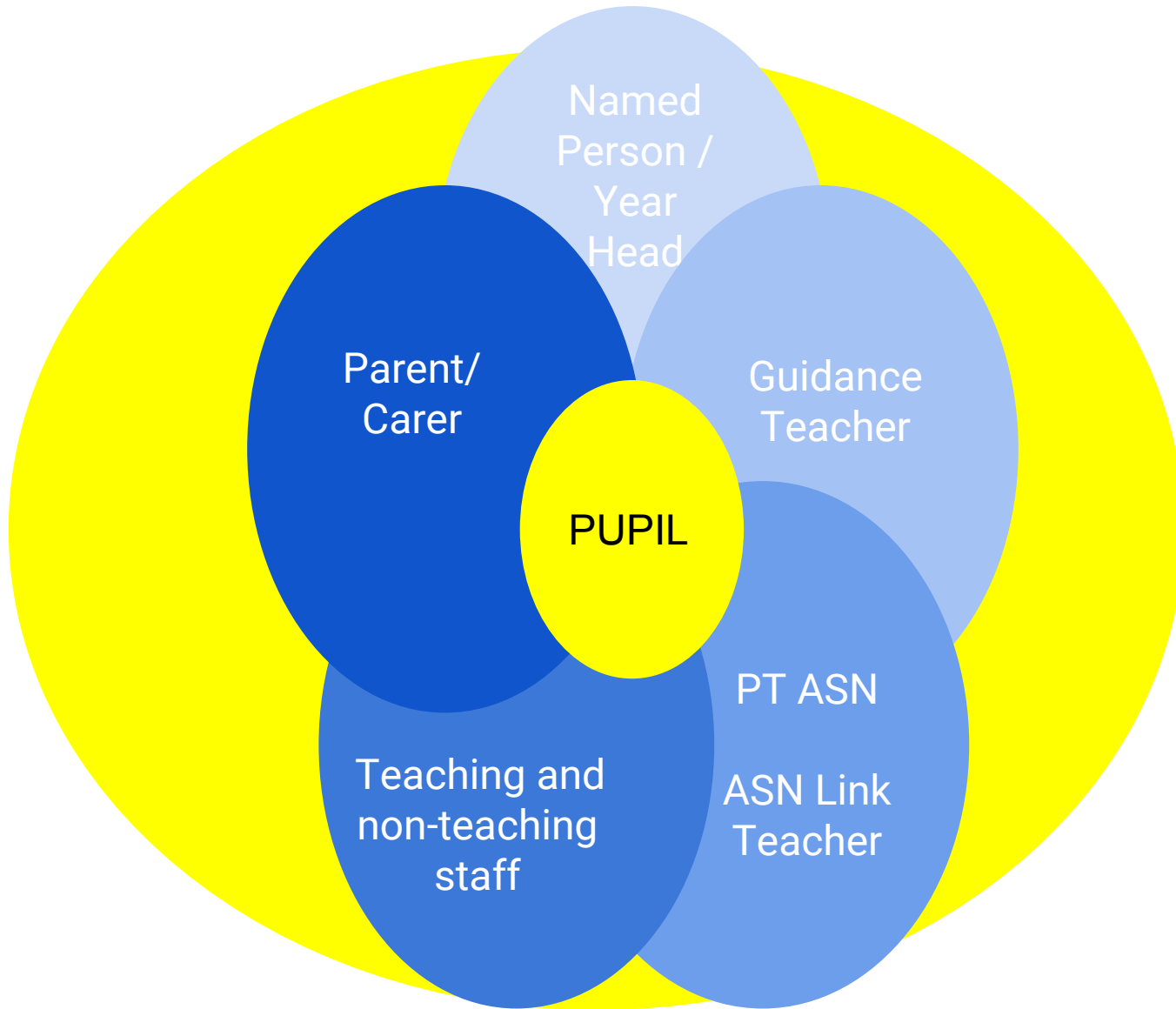
