


#### National 3 & National 4

- Consists of two or three units plus Added Value Unit
- The units are assessed within the class
- No external exam
- Pupils must pass all units
- Pass/Fail

#### National 3 & National 4



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
## Higher & AH

- Consist of two or three units plus course assessment (e.g. exam plus coursework).
- Units = assessed within the class (subject to verification)
- Course assessment = externally assessed (exceptions apply)


Exam + coursework = Final grade



## Importance of Internal Unit Assessments

- To ensure candidates have achieved minimum competency & to support learning
- Cannot gain course award without them
- Two attempts to pass(third in exceptional circumstances)
- Problems with rescheduling due to absence
- What happens if a pupil doesn't achieve the internal assessments?




## Why has N5 changed?

'The removal of mandatory unit assessments has the distinct purpose of reducing the amount of assessment experienced by young people taking national qualifications and the workload created as a result of administering the units.'




### Changes to Exam/Coursework


## **N5 Units Only**

- SCQF5
- Stand alone units
- Internally assessed
- No final exam
- Not graded

### Why would a pupil be entered for Units only?

- Need more challenge than N4 but not at N5 exam level
- Not coping with demands of course
- No fall back if they failed exam
- No N4 available

# Exceptional Circumstances

There must be a fundamental disadvantage affecting exam day:

Personal circumstances:

bereavement

medical (not common cold, sore head etc)

domestic

Examination circumstances:

incorrect assessment arrangements

extreme disruption

# Post Results Service

If pupil's results are <u>markedly at odds with estimated</u> <u>grade/overall performance</u>, school can request:



Check that marks tally and the correct total is entered



Clerical check plus Senior Examiner remarks paper
