- Time-keeping

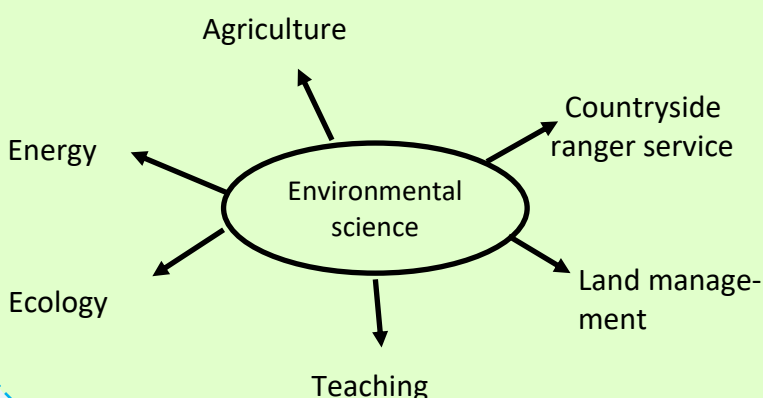
How will I be assessed?
