


National 3 & National 4

- Consists of two or three units plus Added Value Unit
- The units are assessed within the class
- No external exam
- Pupils must pass all units
- Pass/Fail




National 5, Higher & AH

- Consist of two or three units plus course assessment (e.g. exam).
- Units = assessed within the class (subject to verification)
- Course assessment = externally assessed (exceptions apply)
 External Question Paper (exam)— May/June
 Assignment/portfolio/performance Spring term
- National 5/Higher graded A-D or No Award
 Course assessment only determines the pupil's final grade.

Importance of Internal Unit Assessments

- To ensure candidates have achieved minimum competency & to support learning
- Cannot gain course award without them
- Two attempts to pass(third in exceptional circumstances)
- Problems with rescheduling due to absence
- What happens if a pupil doesn't achieve the internal assessments?





Speaking from experience ...

 Don't make ridiculous study aims.

Make quality notes that you understand.

 Study the material you don't understand and not the material you do – get out of your comfort zone!



Speaking from experience ...

 Short, focused study sessions. Quality rather than quantity.

 Make use of your class time and concentrate on new material your teachers give you. If you are finding past papers a bit tricky, do a few with your notes beside you before going on to practise in exam conditions.

How do I know they are studying?!

 Reading alone of limited value

 Study session made up of shorter revision blocks Reading and ...

- Mind Maps
- Revision Notes
- Post it notes
- Highlighted key words

How can I help?

- Build revision time into family life
- Create a quiet space
- Reward cups of tea chocolate biscuits!
- Breaks from revision

Help consolidate revision by

- Reading over summary notes
- Asking for explanation of mind map
- Timed past papers
- Ask for explanation of answers
